\$2,500 donation from HWE Mining to help local volunteer fire fighters

HWE Mining is donating \$2,500 to the South Kalgoorlie Volunteer Fire and Rescue Service (VFRS) to help with its Fire Station upgrade.

Local Kalgoorlie resident and HWE Mining Project Manager Wayne Gough said the donation will be put towards building materials for a new outdoor area to help make the Hare Street Fire Station more family friendly.

“The volunteers want to build a gazebo and put in a children’s play area for members’ families to enjoy when at the Fire Station for training, meetings and the monthly local fire fighter competitions,” Mr Gough said.

“We are proud to be able to give the South Kalgoorlie VFRS a donation to help make this happen – and to support the hard working volunteers of this fantastic local emergency service, who do so much for the community.”

The South Kalgoorlie VFRS, with the full support of the Fire and Emergency Services Authority of WA, has already restored much of the 1930s heritage listed building – with a lot of volunteer hours also being put into the project.

The living quarters have undergone extensive and impressive refurbishment, and the fully restored old pump room now proudly displays South Kalgoorlie VFRS memorabilia, trophies and historical photos.
